### **COMPETITION RULES**

- 1 There will be four sections of the competition:

**A/ Open Class Event for Players with a physical disability ambulant**

**B/ Open Class Event for Players with a physical disability using a wheelchair**

**C/ Open Class for Players with a learning disability**

**D/ Open Class for Junior Players aged under 18 (any disability)**

(the organiser reserves the right to combine categories if entries in some categories are low)

- 2 The Table Tennis events will be conducted in accordance with the current rules of the ITTF modified for Table Tennis players with a learning and physical disability.
- 3 A game will be won by the player(s) first scoring 11 points. In the event that both players reach 11 points each, the match will be won by the first player(s) scoring 2 points more than the opposing player(s). A match is the best of five games.
- 4 All competitors will be expected to serve correctly. This requirement may be relaxed when notification is made before play begins.
- 5 All players will be expected to wear a t-shirt (not white), shorts and trainers. All players will be expected to supply their own bat with regulation black and red rubbers.
- 6 In the event that there are not enough entries to hold all classes or sections, the organisers have the right to amalgamate classes or sections.
- 7 **ENTRY FEE** The entry fee will be £5.00 per person. Cheques should be made payable to **“Grampian Disability Sport”**.

### **Grampian Game Athlete Code of Conduct – Table Tennis**

**Aim: To ensure that all athletes/coaches involved with G.D.S. participate within an agreed philosophy and set of standards.**

#### **Principle Statement of Ethics**

Sporting integrity is based on the acceptance of rules, fairness, equality, respect for others, moral conduct and a sense of what is right. The goal of G.D.S. is to create a sporting environment where violence, breaking the rules, the abuse of drugs, the lack of fair play and other unethical behaviour are automatically rejected as being irrelevant to the true purpose of sport.

I the athlete/coach agree to the following:

1. to abide by the principle statement on Ethics above
2. practice and play within the spirit of the game
3. help each other to learn new skills
4. compete as a team
5. respect others – coach, officials, other players, team managers, parents who help organise/play the sport
